



How to Apply for a Marriage License:

FYI- (There is **NO** blood test required!)

(If you are planning on getting married in Massachusetts, you can file for a marriage at **ANY** Town Clerk's Office in Massachusetts)

(The marriage intention is only **valid for 60 days from the day you apply** for it & there is a **legal 3 day waiting period from the day you apply until you can pick the license up and be married;** please plan accordingly)

If you decide to come to file with the Town of Milford, both persons must come together to "apply" for the license. **The hours for filing are 8:30am-4:00pm, Monday through Friday.**

If either party does not speak or understand English, that person should bring a translator and be in the Town Clerk's office no later than 3:00pm (the paperwork might take awhile to complete).

The **fee** to apply for a marriage license is **\$25.00** (payable in cash or money order **only**).

****NOTE: Other information we will need when you arrive includes:**

- Valid Photo I.D. (license or passport acceptable)
- Social Security Number/information
- Date of Marriage, Place of Marriage (street address), and Officiant's name & home address. ****If Officiant does not live in Massachusetts-they need to file for a ONE DAY Solemnization with the Secretary of State's office in Boston before** filing with the Town Clerk-**we will keep the original certificate that is issued to that person** when you apply.
